

Hunky Hat

This hat is made with *Textiles A Mano* "Big Hunk" yarn. It is very easy and fast to make. Two sizes are provided in this pattern for a hunky and a hunkier head. This hat is reversible, turn up the brim, or pull down to keep ears warm and grab your snowboard.

Materials

Yarn is provided in the kit. Changing the pattern or the size may result in a shortage of yarn. One skein of "Big Hunk" from *Textiles A Mano* will make 2 hats.

Needles

US 13 circular 16 inch and a set of same size double point needles.

Gauge: 2 sts per inch knit in the round

Instructions

Hunky Hat: CO 42, Hunkier hat: 45 sts. Place a marker at the beginning of the round. Being careful not to twist the sts; join in a circle.

Rd 1: K1, P1 all around

Rd 2: K all around

Rd 3: repeat rd 1

Rd 4 and all rds following: knit

Continue for approximately 6 inches. Try the hat on, there is enough yarn in the kit to add a few rows.

Decrease Rounds

Change to double point needles.

Hunky Hat:

K2 tog, K5 around

K2 tog, K4 around

K2 tog, K3 around

K2 tog, K2 around

K2 tog, K1 around

K2 tog around

Hunkier Hat:

K2 tog, K7 around

K2 tog, K6 around

K2 tog, K5 around

K2 tog, K4 around

K2 tog, K3 around

K2 tog, K2 around

K2 tog, K1 around

K2 tog around

Cut yarn leaving a 6 inch tail. Thread a tapestry needle and pass through the remaining sts a couple of times. Pull tight; push needle through center; weave in neatly so the hat can be reversible. Weave in cast on tail. Head for the slopes!

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
